Courses related to **food engineering, quality and safety** will be designed by **AUT, UHZ, and UNBI**. Scientific staff of **USAMVB and ReadLab** will act mainly as mentors of their colleagues of partner countries HEIs.

Courses related to **food production systems management** will be designed by **EUT, UC and UNSA**. Scientific staff of **CULS, AUA and ReadLab** will act mainly as mentors of their colleagues of partner countries HEIs.

This report is addressed to the partners of the STEPS project, as well as to the interested teaching staff and technical staff.

## 2 . Teaching staff of STEPS MSc Program

### 2.1 Methodology

Scientific staff of partner countries of HEIs and EU are organised in working groups, according to the courses that HEIs will deliver during the implementation of the MSc programme and assess their needs in terms specific scientific topics that will be included in the content of courses.

Each consortium partner will be represented in these working groups, by a list of the names, contact information of the each person according to their scientific background and the STEPS Curriculum Desing.

---

The working groups include the scientific staff participating also in seminars/lectures and involved in the development of research labs and the experiments and simulations after the installation of the modern equipment in partner HEIs countries.

Scientific staff from partner countries HEIs will provide major contribution to the design of courses. Scientific staff from EU partner countries will, mainly, offer guidance on the interrelation of scientific topics addressed by the courses and the development of STEPS related topics and subjects that need to be included.

## 2.2 . Criteria's of teaching staff selection

The mission of the STEPS MSc program is justified by elements of relevance and opportunity in relation to the objectives of education and scientific research, as well as with the national qualification list and, respectively, with the requirements of the labor market described in D1.1. and D2.1.

All teaching positions of set up in accordance with the legal norms will be covered by **teachers qualified in the higher education according to the law:**

- **the academic staff in higher education institutions includes professors, associated professors, lecturers and assistant lecturers;**
- lecturers and assistant lecturers (**provided they have a PhD**), associate professors and full professors may teach at **all levels of higher education;**
- the holders of the disciplines must have the **title of doctor in the field of the taught discipline.**

Teachers competences including fair and transparent procedures for recruitment and development of faculty staff.

The other criteria for selection of teachers are:

- familiar to the concepts of ECTS and the learning-outcomes approach, which will be used for the development of every chapter/section of the educational content
- familiar with the use of ICT-based educational tools.

## 2.3 Teaching staff of working groups

In conformity with the official document regarding **Characteristics of STEPS Joint Master Program, between HEIs universities per countries**, the teaching staff was divided in the two groups: ***Food engineering, quality and safety*** and ***Food production systems management*** - according to:

- **the experience and specificity of the universities partners;**
- **the scientific background of teachers;**

- **organisation of STEPS MSc program in each HEIs universities: number of years studies, core and elective courses, ECST .**

This classification was used for the development of teaching staff working groups for STEPS MSc program. Scientific staff will be involved in the development of educational material, research labs, experiments simulations and accompanying material.

Scientific staff will improve its teaching capacity by delivering up-to date knowledge on innovative concepts while on the other hand, modern infrastructures and equipment, including ICT-based educational tools as well as experimental and scientific software tools will offer them the opportunity to organise innovative learning experiences for students. The fruitful collaboration between scientific staff of the HEIs involved in the consortium is expected to extend during the delivery of the courses and after the project lifetime.

Scientific staff for all partners HEIs will assess their needs in terms of scientific background improvements and also teaching competences, related in particular with ICT-based methodologies, student-centred approaches and modern teaching/learning environments.

### 3 . CONCLUSIONS

The most important conclusions drawn from this report are:

- The material present the **List of Scientific staff of partner countries of HEIs and EU** organised in working groups, according to the List of Courses and Course Curriculum included in D2.1.
- Scientific staff for all partners was organised in working groups, according to the two groups of courses by their scientific background and capacity.
- Courses related to **food engineering, quality and safety** will be designed by **AUT, UHZ, UNSA and UNBI**. Scientific staff of **USAMVB and ReadLab** will act mainly as mentors of their colleagues of partner countries HEIs.
- Courses related to **food production systems management** will be designed by **EUT, UC, UNSA and UNBI**. Scientific staff of **CULS, AUA and ReadLab** will act mainly as mentors of their colleagues of partner countries HEIs.
- The **criteria's for selection of teachers were in accordance with the legal norms** and also, **will be familiar to the concepts of ECTS** and the **learning-outcomes approach**, which will be used for the

development of every chapter/section of the educational content and with the **use of ICT-based educational tools.**

- **Scientific staff of HEIs will be involved in Course Description**, the development of educational material, research labs, experiments simulations and accompanying material.
- The report presents the lists of the names of teaching staff, contact information of each person of HEIs and EU partners according to their scientific background and the STEPS Curriculum Design.
- The working groups include also the scientific staff participating in seminars/lectures and will be involved in the development of research labs and the experiments and simulations after the installation of the modern equipment in partner HEIs countries.
- Scientific staff from partner countries HEIs will provide the contribution to the design of courses.
- Scientific staff from EU partner countries will offer guidance, mainly, on the interrelation of scientific topics addressed by the courses and the development of STEPS related topics and subjects that need to be included.
- **The Course Description is the responsibility of the six HEIs universities partners.**
- **The Course Description forms will include the following data: the institution organizing the course, the teaching staff (teachers for lectures and practical applications), list of topics of course and number of hours, a list of practical application (lab, study visits, projects, and seminars), evaluation.**  
**According to the Course Curricula included in D2.1. report.**
- **All this documents (Course Curriculum, List of Courses – Core and Elective, number of hours per activity, number of ECTS per course, names of teachers, List of topics for lectures and List of topics for practical applications) must be in direct connection with the documents for the accreditation elaborated at National level by HEIs universities.**
